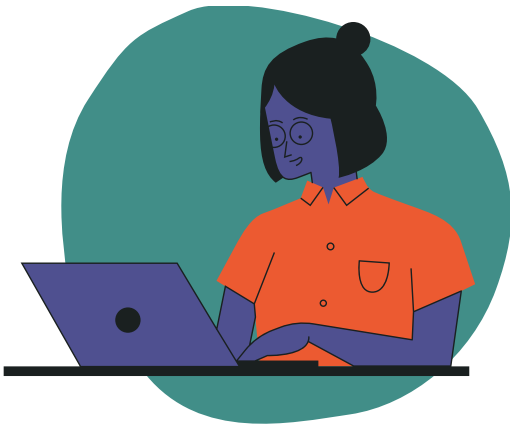


# CASPA Fee Assistance Program

## What Is The Fee Assistance Program?

A core belief at PAEA is that an applicant's finances should not be a barrier to applying to a PA program. Each cycle, PAEA provides a limited number of fee waivers to qualified applicants. The fee waivers are awarded on a first come, first served basis.

Applicants with an adjusted gross income that falls 200% below the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services Poverty Guidelines on their federal income tax return qualify to receive a fee waiver.



## How Will I Know If An Applicant Has Been Awarded A Fee Waiver?

If you require proof that an applicant received a CASPA fee waiver before granting a secondary fee waiver, you can request email verification or a screenshot of the receipt directly from the applicant.



## What Can I Do With This Information?

Each waiver covers the cost of the first two programs (\$235). To help remove one area of potential bias, PA Programs will no longer be able to see an applicant's fee waiver status in WebAdMIT. Programs will now indicate secondary fee waiver availability on the CASPA program page.
